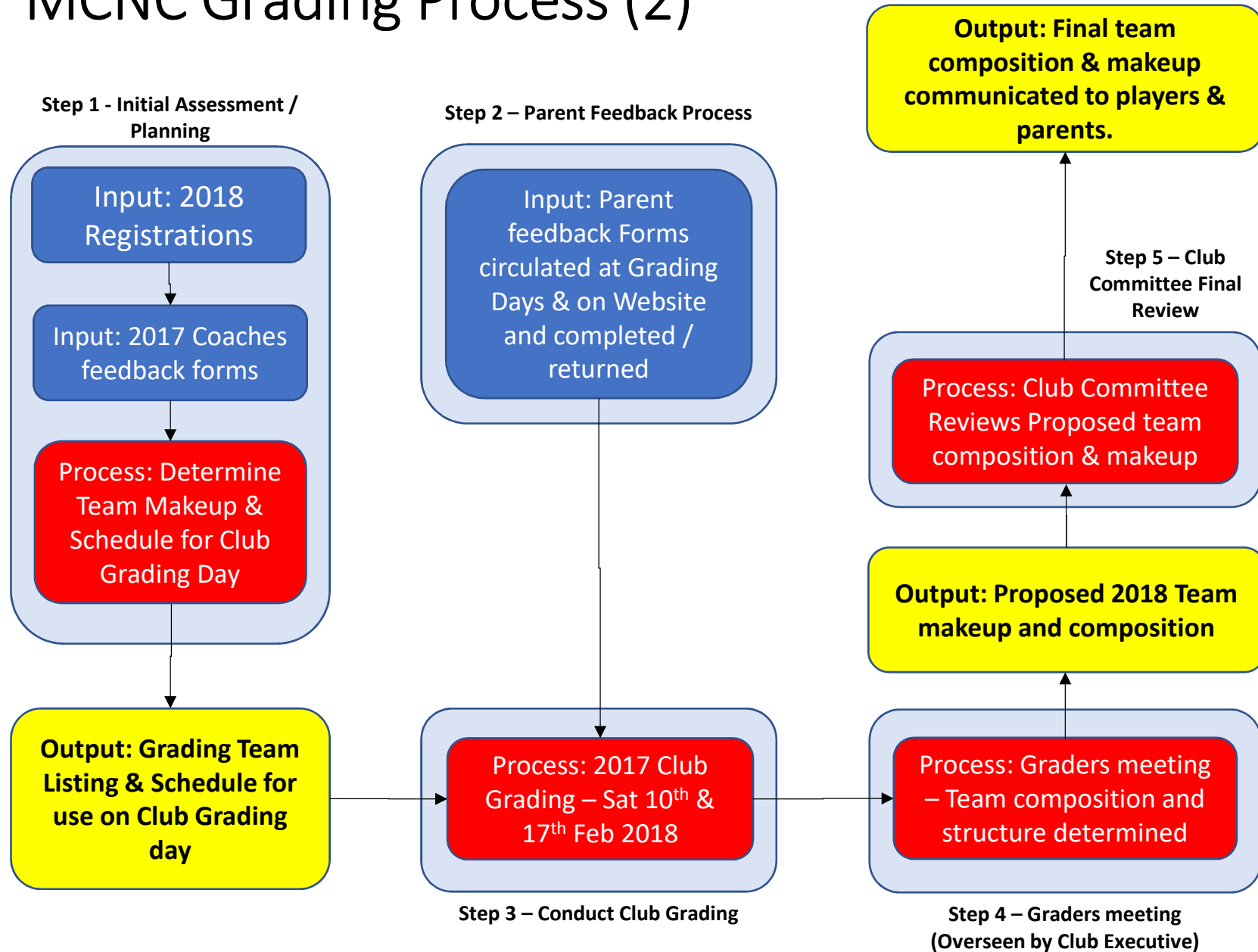
# MCNC Grading Process (1)

- Guiding Principle:
  - **Where possible**, (refer considerations/factors below) 2017 teams will be kept together. This means the club will endeavour to try and keep the nucleus of teams together **where able**.
- Considerations/Factors: **(In order or Priority)**
  1. **Player ability** – Aim is to have similar skill levels across players within a team,
  2. **Team Fit** – Position preference or ability (type of player: Defender / Midfielder / Attacker), *e.g. we cant put together a team of goal shooters, or centres!!!*
  3. **Development requirements** – Remain at level or even go down a level due to need for further development,
  4. **Parents wishes / Other Factors** (Specific needs around: Training, game drop off, playing with friends, other issues, etc...)

Please note that the club has over 200 players of differing and varying skill levels to grade. This means that while we will try to ensure that parents and players desires are met, this may not always be possible.

**Note: The MCNC and SCNA Divisional Competition Grading process is a skill (ability) based grading system and is not based on age or school year.**

# MCNC Grading Process (3)

- Step 1:
  - Registrar provides list of all 2018 registered players.
  - Coaches feedback forms reviewed.
  - Graders determine Session listing and schedule for grading day(s).
- Step 2:
  - Parent feedback forms disseminated, completed, collected and collated for use during team composition process.
- Step 3:
  - Grading Conducted – Sat 10<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018. Graders comments captured for each player as observed during grading games.
- Step 4:
  - Graders meet to determine team composition and makeup, using Club Guiding Principle and Other Factors/Consideration guidelines – as detailed on slide (1).
  - Output proposed team composition and makeup provided to MCNC Committee for review.
- Step 5:
  - Committee reviews proposed team composition and makeup.
  - Final team composition and makeup communicated to players & parents.
